

1) If you are **TRAVELLING BY CAR**, you can **only** access the port via the entrance on McKinley way, Newhaven that leads to **DOCK Gate 4**. Aim for the McDonalds in Newhaven and use the postcode BN9 0FB in your sat nav, or What3words- workbook.expressed.mimes




Once through the Security Gate, we are on the first Left Hand bend- parking inside the bright yellow crash barriers.

2) If you are **TRAVELLING ON FOOT OR BIKE** you can **only** access the port via the East Quay entrance on Beach Road, Newhaven- use postcode BN9 0BX or what3words- pens.overtones.loads



Once through the security gate/barrier to the East Quay, you will need to collect a Hi-Viz vest from the box by the Security Office.

You will then walk/cycle across the railway lines. The road forks just after the railway lines. You must turn **LEFT** here:



You will see a tall grey building in the distance with 2 signs on. We are there.



IF YOU HAVE A COURSE RUNNING ON A SATURDAY AND/OR SUNDAY OR BANK HOLIDAY:

When you arrive at the East Quay entrance AT THE WEEKEND ONLY you will need to press the buzzer to gain entry through the large locked gates. THIS ENTRANCE IS ONLY FOR PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLES. (All cars should continue use the vehicle access at Dock Gate 4).

You will be remotely buzzed in by the Gate Security team who monitor the site from the Vehicle access point at Gate 4. Please note that they don't have time to speak much once the buzzer is activated- they aren't being rude! Just listen for the buzz and push the gates.
